PROFILE

Daniel Statham studied Architecture at the **Bartlett, University College London** and established his own practice in 2006. Much of his early work was collaborating with artists **Langlands & Bell, Juan Munoz and Marc Quinn** and developing new construction techniques and methods with **Atelier One**. Professional experience was broadened further with **Sir Norman Foster and Partners** and **Barber Osgerby**.

The practice's first commission was a collaboration to design an exhibition space for **China's Terracotta Army at the British Museum**, London which was a showcase event in the UK during 2007. This work was to proceed with commissions and collaborations for the **United Nations HQ** and **Times Square Redevelopment** in New York, the Singapore Pavilion for **EXPO 2010** in Shanghai, the **Buddhist Cultural Museum** in Singapore and working with Santiago Calatrava on the facade of the **Chicago Spire** in the United States which on completion will be the tallest residential skyscraper in the World. The practice has since been commissioned to work on a range of civic and housing projects in London, Madrid, Tokyo, Singapore, Shanghai, Toulouse and the Greek Islands.

The practice has recently been awarded **First Prize** on a commercial tower for **CDL HQ** in Singapore and a **Pavilion for the EXPO 2010** in Shanghai in addition to being short listed on projects in New York, Shanghai and Amsterdam. The practice also contributed works to launching the DreamSpace gallery in Shoreditch, London which celebrates up and coming British designers as well as exhibiting at the **Vanderbilt Hall, Grand Central Station, New York**.

Daniel Statham has tutored and lectured at several design events and schools in London including the **Architectural Association**, University of the Arts and Westminster School of Architecture. The practice is also involved in the London based **'Workshop Collective'** which is a group of creative's from various disciplines within the industry including **Apple, Zumtobel** and **Missoni**.

The studio is based in **London** and **Madrid**. The practice is multi-disciplinary and is currently working on a variety of projects within the industry.
